COVID-19 Impact on Extended Property Tax Payment Due Date in Florida

State mandated closures and other governmental regulations issued to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 are drastically impacting the business world. Property tax is normally due by March 31 in the year following the tax assessment. All tax collectors shall consider property taxes timely paid if received by electronic payment or postmarked by April 15, 2020. This is pursuant to Order of Emergency Waiver/Deviation #20-52-DOR-01 and applies to all 67 Florida counties.
